SOUTHEAST HEAVY LIVE HEN REPORT, MARCH 4, 1996. FEDERAL-STATE

Final majority prices were unchanged to lower compared to a week ago. Movement from production areas was fully adequate to ample, easily fulfilling slaughter needs for this week. Demand was light to moderate at best. Finished sales were seasonally slower at declining values. The market tone was barely steady to weak.

EASTERN REGION FROZEN EGGS, MARCH 01, 1996. FEDERAL-STATE

Prices were generally higher except whites which were about unchanged. The market tone was fully steady to firm for whole egg and especially yolks, and steady to instances fully steady for whites.

Demand remained limited and centered on small volumes to cover immediate needs only. Floor stocks were no more than adequate as most breakers processed for current orders. Edible liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending February 24, 1996 were 99 less than last week, and 13% less than the same week last year.
