OKLAHOMA CITY, OK
MARCH 13, 1996

Compared to Monday of last week: Feeder cattle and calves steady to 1.00 lower. Stocker cattle steady to 2.00 higher. Demand very good for thin fleshed cattle, moderate for all other classes. Quality average to attractive. Weigh-ups gaunt to average, few full. Feeder cattle in medium to modest flesh and increasing from week to week. Stockers and calves medium to mostly thin flesh. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to .50 lower, except Breakers .50 higher. Demand very good for fleshier cows, moderate for other cows and bulls. Total of 300 cows and bulls sold with 85 percent to packers. Dry conditions persist in the Oklahoma wheat belt. Minor chance of

rain forecasted for Thursday thru Saturday but nothing substantial. State still waiting for opening of gulf weather patterns. Receipts this week 14,475; last week 15,585; last year 16,934. Supply consisted of 82 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 16 percent calves; 2 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 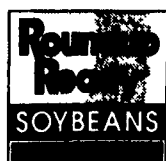
