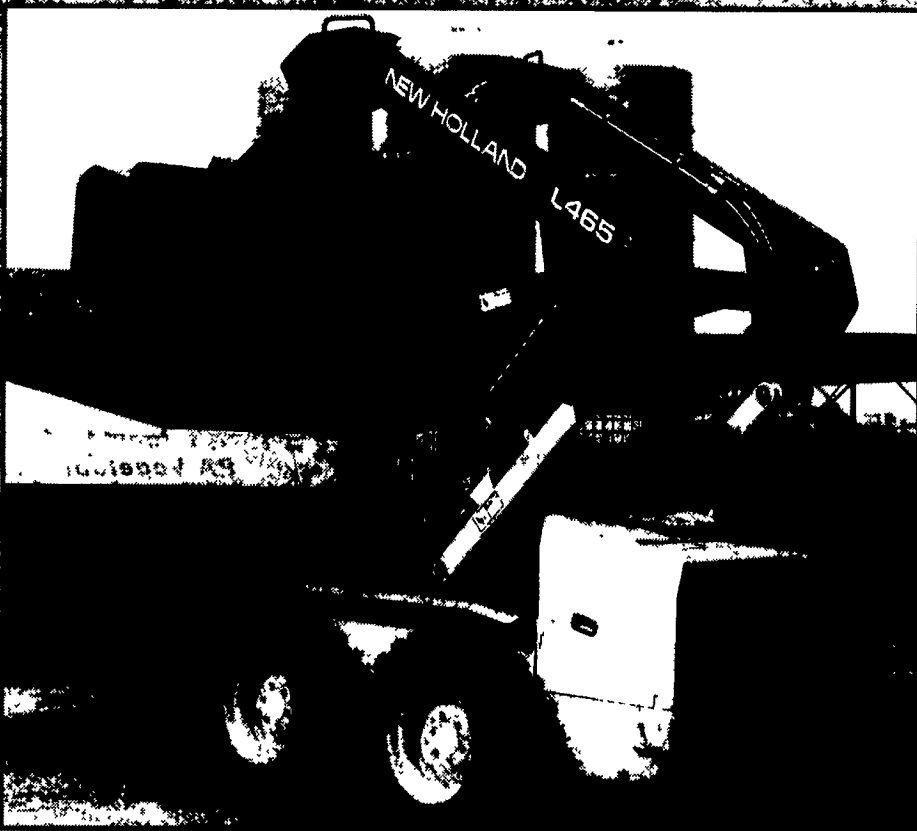
they were featured in a recent issue of Holstein World.
