

Fruit Growers Meet, Twilight Meetings Announced

MOUNT JOY (Lancaster Co.) — More than 44 Lancaster County Fruit Growers Association members and friends attended the annual banquet last week at The Country Table Restaurant.

Dr. Tim Elkner, Lancaster County horticultural agent, spoke about his background as an extension agent in Texas before joining Lancaster County Penn State Cooperative Extension last year.

Elkner provided some details of his work at a recent interview at his office.

What proves challenging for Elkner is the diversity of horticulture in the county, encompassing not only fruit production but vegetables and turf.

"So many areas to cover can prove really frustrating at times," he admitted, indicating the calls that come in regarding some of the

seasonal pests faced by orchardists and homeowners.

A big problem during the winter are the turf "voles" that are busy, after the snow melts, eating bark off trees and eating other plants. The extension office has also fielded calls on box elder bugs, a black bag with orange or red stripes and a long, shield-like shape, that are busy seeking warmth after emergence.

Elkner will be busy winding up the meeting season in the next several weeks, speaking to Farm Women #8 and at a PennAg Industries meeting.

Elkner indicated that the Lancaster Fruit Growers twilight meeting is scheduled on May 2 at Amos Fisher's Farm in Strasburg, at 6 p.m. The York County Fruit Growers meeting is scheduled on June 4 at the Paul McPherson farm

at 6 p.m.
