

Dairylea Enters Full-Supply Agreement

SYRACUSE, N.Y. — Dairylea Cooperative Inc. has recently entered into a new, full-supply milk marketing agreement with Nestle's Fulton, N.Y. manufacturing

operation. Under their new "Value-Managed Relationships (VMR)" protocol, Nestle utilizes less suppliers but works more closely with

them, strengthening relationships and ensuring the fulfillment of their supply needs.

"We are very pleased with our continually expanding relation-

ship with a quality organization such as Nestle," said Dairylea's Chief Executive Officer Rick Smith. "This new agreement is a valuable outlet for milk from farmers in the area."

Just five years ago, Dairylea was one of many suppliers to the plant. Under the new full-supply agreement, the plant's entire supply will be provided by Dairylea member farms in Wayne, Ontario, Oswego, Onondaga, Madison, Herki-

mer, Onondaga, St. Lawrence, Cayuga, Lewis and Jefferson counties.

Dairylea is a Syracuse-based dairy cooperative with more than 32,500 member farms throughout the Northeast. It markets nearly 4 billion pounds of milk annually and participates and is invested in a milk marketing network stretching from Maine to Maryland to Ohio.
