## OKLAHOMA CITY, OK MAY 1, 1996

Compared to Monday of last week: Feeder cattle steady to 1.00 lower. Stocker cattle steady to 2.00 higher. Demand good for both stockers and feeders although buyers remain fairly selective for best kinds. Quality of the supply much improved from last week with large percentage average to attractive. Weigh condition favored sellers with cattle in average to full condition, few gaunt and conditions fuller than last week. Feeder flesh mostly medium; old crop stocker flesh thin to very thin. Few isolated

sales of fleshy new crop calves 8.00-10.00 below thin old crops quoted in ML 1 grade. Demand improved with Friday and Monday's cattle futures limit up trade. Downturns in grain markets the stablizing factor as rains in combelt improved outlook for commodity traders. Rain forecasted for Sunday and Monday in the Oklahoma wheat belt did not materialize as traces were the most common reading. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to 1.00 higher. Demand good from packers. 737 cows and bulls sold 70 percent going to packers. Receipts this week \$,335; last week 7,100; last year 18,886. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 17 percent calves and yearlings under 600 lbs; 9 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
