CRUMB CAKES 5 cups flour

2 cups sugar

½ cup shortening

Mix together like pie crust. Reserve % cup flour crumbs for top. Add the following:

2 cups thick milk (Add 1 tablespoon lemon juice or vinegar per cup to milk)

2 teaspoons baking soda

Mix well. Pour into pie pans and bake at 350 degrees until thoothpick comes out clear.

1/2 teaspoon pepper 2 teaspoons chili powder

For sauce, put in a separate bowl and mix well:

2 cups ketchup

11/2 cups packed brown sugar

2 tablespoons liquid smoke 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/2 cup chopped onion

Shape meatball mixture into left me start cooking and baking at balls. Place in a single layer in one or two 13x9x2-inch baking pans. Cover with sauce and bake for one hour. Makes 15 large meatballs or about 60 small ones.


