

Make 1 layer in the bottom of the dish with shells. Pour over sauce, then put a layering sauce, shells, sauce, cheese, shells, etc. until finished. Top with sauce and shredded cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 30-45 minutes. Serves 6-8.


