unexpected breach birth in one of the goats, she recalled the instructions for helping in the delivery of a breach birth and remembered to keep the legs bent backward to assist in a healthy delivery.

Most of the Ogden goats are kept to increase the herd, but some are sold at four months of age at an auction.

Oliver said that raising goats can be a lucrative business. While cow's milk averages \$14 per hundredweight, goat milk sold for cheese averages \$26 per hundredweight. In addition the ethnic market for meat goats continues to

Some of the goat milk is bottlefed to the kids and the remainder Oliver pasteurizes for he and his wife's use and for friends.
