

# NAAB Prepares For 50th Anniversary Convention

COLUMBIA, Mo. — The 50th Anniversary Convention of the National Association of Animal Breeders (NAAB) will be held August 28-30, at the Cheyenne Mountain Resort, Colorado Springs, Colo. This year's host is ABS Global, Inc., DeForest, Wis.

Colorado Springs boasts three of Colorado's most popular tourist attractions, the U.S. Air Force Academy, Pikes Peak Cog Railway, and the sports activities related to the U.S. Olympic Training Center.

In addition to anniversary celebration highlights, there will be great excitement and fun for all members, guests, and families. Starting with a gold tournament on Wednesday, August 28, the fun

continues with a host reception that evening and the kickoff of the convention the following morning. Other highlights of the convention will include award recognition, a keynote speaker, business sessions, an educational program, and more. The convention will adjourn Friday noon, August 30.

Attendees at Thursday morning's general business session will hear the annual address by NAAB Chairman of the Board, Bruce Bean. AI technicians who have serviced more than 100,000 cows, as well as industry sales people who have sold over 500,000 units of semen, will be recognized with a plaque presentation ceremony. After a break, spouses will be offered a choice of shopping and/

or tours of the area.

The latter part of the morning session will focus on the business at hand with the call to order, call to the meeting, and the reading of any proposed resolutions which may come before the assembly. The chairman of the Nominating Committee, Roger Ripley, will report on candidates for the NAAB board of directors.

Speakers at the afternoon educational session will feature discussion on current and potential sire health issues. Officials from USDA will present results from a recent survey of the health of dairy farm animals and summarize BSE prevention measures in the USA. Dr. Don Monke of Select Sires will give an overview of emerging

health issues concerning the AI industry. The session will be topped off with a presentation from Dr. George Siedel of Colorado State University. He will talk about the impact of new animal breeding technologies with specific emphasis on fine tuning semen processing.

Thursday night's banquet guests will enjoy an anniversary tribute, besides the NAAB awards ceremonies. This year's recipients are Donald P. Solberg, 21st Century Genetics, Distinguished Service Award; Hubert Goode, Tennessee/Select Sires, Member Association Director Award; Dr. Fred I. (Irv) Elliott, ABS Global (deceased), Pioneer Award; and Dr. George R. Wiggins, USDA/

AIPL, Research Award.

At Friday morning's business session NAAB voting delegates will elect three directors to fill the three vacant positions. Those whose terms expire this year are Jon Mast, Noba, Inc., Richard Chichester, Select Sires, and Ken Leick, 21st Century Genetics. Both Chichester and Leick are eligible to serve a second three-year term.

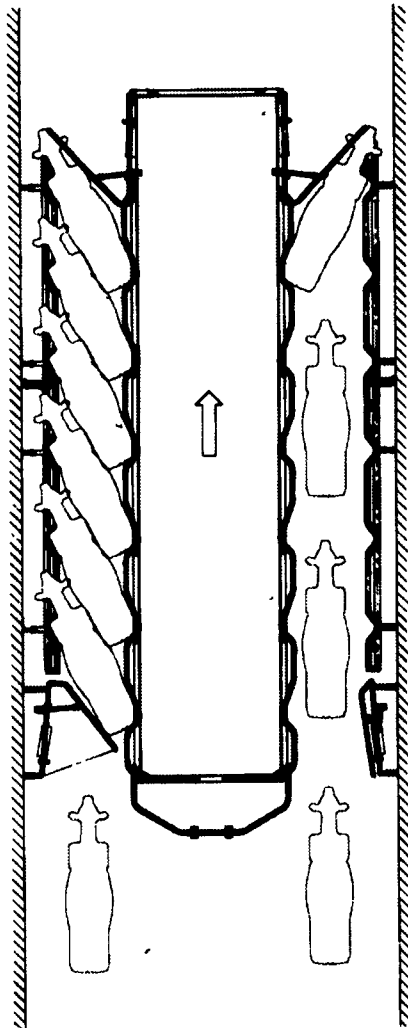
