Maslany, director of the air radiation and toxics division at EPA's Region III office in Philadelphia. "We will use the public's input for improving the way we administer the regulations."

Maslany said the agency needs to find out if employers and workers understand the federal requirements, and if there's been success or difficulty in implementing the requirements. Information on available assistance will be of-


