

OK City Feeder Cattle

OKLAHOMA CITY, OK
JUNE 12, 1996

Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves 1.00-2.00 higher. Demand very good on English and exotic cross cattle, excellent for Brahma crosses. Combelt buyers very active. Quality average, moderate end attractive. Feeder flesh condition medium. Weigh-ups gaunt to full. General attitude in the feeder and slaughter cattle circles is bullish for first time in a year. Low placements in feedlots, smaller show lists, short day slaughter cattle, expected good corn crop, high cow slaughter, and less replacement cows held for breeding are all combining to create this atmosphere of hope. Slaughter cows and bulls firm to 2.00 higher. Packer demand very good with best action from Northern buyers. Demand improved from Texas buyers as the large cow runs in the drought stricken south are winding down. 1,025 cows and bulls sold with 85 percent to packers. Receipts this week 11,775; last week 15,264; last year 9,544. Supply consisted of 72 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 19 percent calves and yearlings under 600 lbs; 9 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
