Compared to last Monday: Feeder steers and heifers 1.00-3.00 higher. Calves and stocker cattle steady to 2.00 higher. Demand very good for feeder cattle, moderate for grazing cattle. Quality plain to average. Feeder cattle in thin to medium flesh. Weigh-ups full to mostly average. Slaughter cows and bulls 1.00-3.00 higher. Demand very good from packers who took 80 percent of the 625 cows and bulls sold. Receipts this week 10,400; last week 11,796; last year 12,114. Supply consisted of 70 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 24 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls. 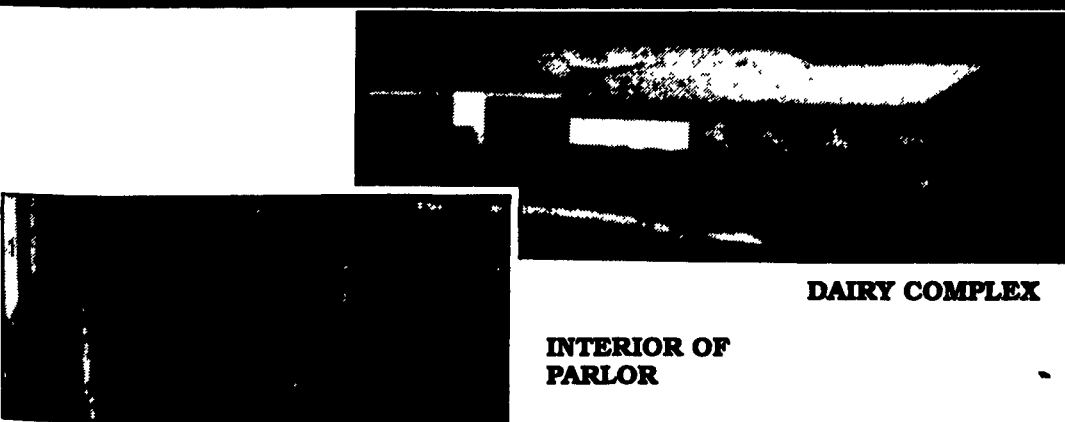

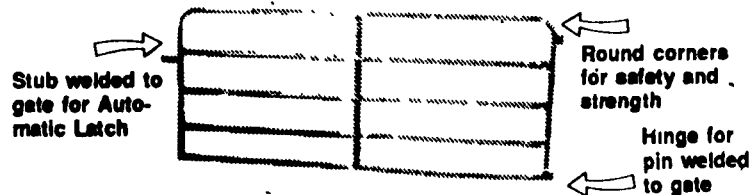
