Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves steady to 2.00 lower with least decline on steers over 700 lbs. Demand moderate. Quality plain to mostly average, moderate end attractive. Flesh condition remains attractive with yearlings in medium to mostly thin flesh. Weigh-ups highly detrimental to prices as cattle in average to mostly full condition. Heat wave continues with pastures suffering. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 higher, advance on Utilities. Slaughter bulls steady. Packer demand light with one buyer dominating the market. Upcoming holiday has several buyers on the sideline. Very hot dry conditions has doubled the cow movement to market. Total of 670 cows and bulls with 80 percent to the packers. Receipts this week 11,750; last week 13,276; last year 505. Supply consisted of 78 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 16 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 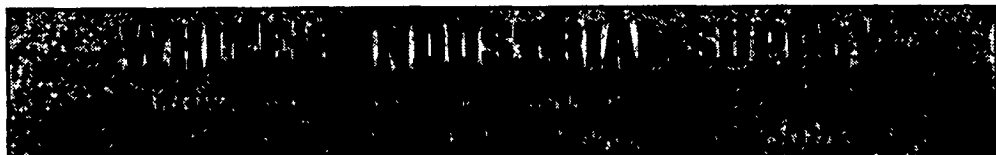
