ly Cattle Summary

Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves firm, with exception of steer calves under 500 lbs 2.00 lower. Demand good for feeders, light to moderate for calves and stockers. Quality plain to average, however overall weigh-ups improved for buyers. Weigh-ups average to full. Feeder cattle in thin to medium flesh conditions. Overcast skies with general rains has lowered temperatures to mid 80's as opposed to 105-112 degrees during past week. Lean cows steady to 1.00 higher. Utility cows steady to 1.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 1.00 lower. Packer demand fairly good with more buyers in market after holiday. 725 cows and bulls sold with 80 percent to packers. Cow run in Oklahoma continues large as drought forcing sell-off. Receipts this week 14,400; last week 11,747; last year 13,336. Supply consisted of 70 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 25 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and prices in parenthesis.
