OKLAHOMA CITY, OK  
JULY 29, 1996

Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves 1.00-2.00 higher. Demand extremely good for both yearling cattle and calves. Quality much improved with moderate end plain but many attractive to average. Weigh-ups average to full. Feeder cattle in thin to medium flesh; calves in medium to fleshy conditions. Weather continues very spring like with temperatures in the 80's and low 90's and afternoon thunderstorms. July moisture has been excellent. Many areas of Oklahoma accumulating 4-10 inches of precip spread throughout the month. Slaughter cows 1.00-2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 2.00 higher. Demand very good from packers with all buyers equally participating. Total of 645 cows and bulls sold, 85 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 8,515; last week 9,666; last year 6,560. Supply consisted of 76 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs; 16 percent calves under 600 lbs; 8 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
