Compared to last Monday: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 2.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves 2.00-3.00 higher. Demand extremely good, especially on cattle over 750 lbs.. Demand very good for calves as price spreads between calves and yearlings has just about diminished. Rains over the past month have made summer grass look more like spring. Quality plain to average, end attractive. Weigh-ups average to full. Feeder cattle and calves in medium to moderate flesh conditions. Slaughter cows 1.00-2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls 2.00-3.00 higher. Demand very good from packers with active trade. Total of 490 cows and bulls sold with 85 percent going packers. Receipts this week 6,800; last week 8,591; last year 8,078. Supply consisted of 73 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs; 20 percent calves under 600 lbs; 7 percent cows and bulls. 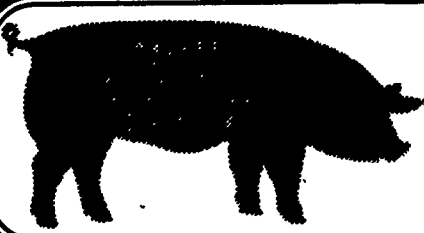
