

Livestock Sale Brings Winners

SHIPPENSBURG (Franklin Co.) — Many local FFA members saw their hard work pay off in cold cash during the 17th annual Robert L. Finkenbinder FFA Livestock Sale held during the Shippensburg Fair.

A main money maker during the market lamb sale was Heather Glennon of the Shippensburg FFA chapter, who sold her grand champion market lamb, a 124-pounder, to Greencastle Livestock for \$300. She also sold her reserve champion 124-pound Hampshire to the G.L. Fogelsanger Agency for \$200.

Another Shippensburg chapter member, Mac Magee, sold his reserve grand champion lamb to Hoss' Steak and Sea House for \$270. The animal weighed 132 pounds.

Michelle Cornman of the Big Spring chapter sold her grand champion pen of two, which weighed in at 229 pounds, to Bill

Peiper for \$370.

Kelli Zeigler of the Big Spring chapter sold her 86-pound champion Columbia to Newville Building Supply for \$150 and her reserve champion Columbia, a 75-pounder, to York Farm Credit for \$150.

William G. Leib of the Cumberland Valley chapter sold his 106-pound champion Shropshire to Wolf Bus Line for \$260. Walek Insurance bought his reserve champion Shropshire, which weighed 102 pounds, for \$220.

Sunday Mill Co. paid \$140 for the 60-pound champion Southdown of Todd Umbrell, a CV chapter member, who also sold his 59-pound reserve champion Southdown to Palmer Green Inc. for \$120.

Josey Fought of the CV chapter sold her 96-pound champion lightweight Hampshire to Ken's Agri for \$180 and got the same price from York Farm Credit for her 110-pound reserve champion lightweight Suffolk.

Dairy for \$140.

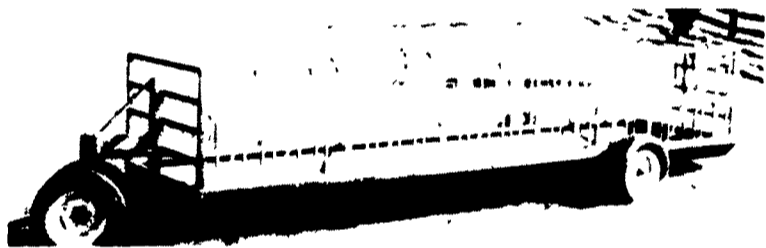
Mac Magee's wallet grew even thicker during the market steer sale when his 1,135-pound grand champion brought \$2,500 from Hoss'.

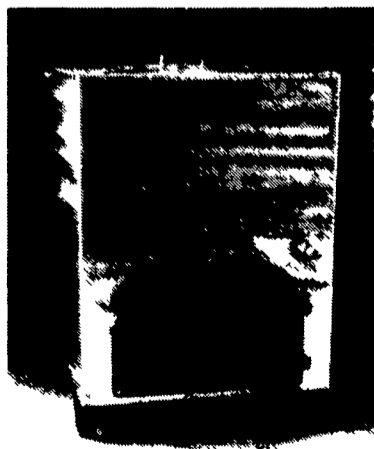

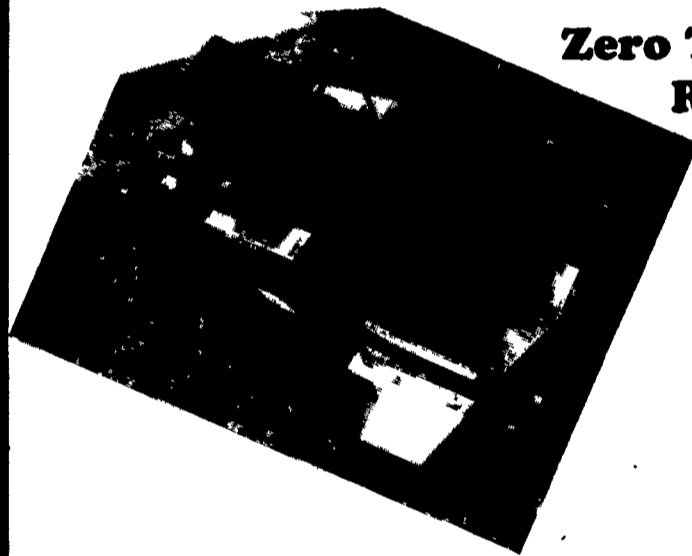
