

In the market hog sale, the big money went to Michelle Cornman, who was paid \$470 by Hatfield Meats for her 248-pound grand champion.

Wade Famer of the Shippensburg chapter sold his 243-pound reserve grand champion to Hoss's for \$360, while Hatfield bought Bobby Davidson's 448-pound champion pen of two for \$470.

The 220-pound champion lightheavyweight hog of Mark Goodhart of the Shippensburg chapter earned \$300 from the G. Leonard Fogelsanger Agency and the Cumberland Valley Co-op paid the same amount for Goodhart's 210-pound reserve champion light-heavyweight.

In all, more than 60 animals were sold at the sale.
