Compared to last week: Feeder steers 1.00-2.00 lower. Feeder heifers and all calves steady.

Demand moderate for feeders; good for calves and stockers. A bullish grain progress report released Monday morning

caused feeder cattle futures to drop the limit. Quality average. Weigh-ups average to many full. Feeder cattle in slightly thin to moderate flesh; calves in medium to fleshy condition with majority unweaned. Slaughter cows and bulls .50-1.50 higher. Packer demand good, especially for fleahier type cows. Total of 785 cows and bulls sold with 85 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 9,100; last week 6,843; last year 8,111. Supply consisted of 74 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 18 percent calves under 600 lbs; 8 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 
