The 86 head of pork-on-the-hoof totaled 19,440 lbs. and sold for a total sale value of \$17,337. The 4-H pigs averaged 226 lbs. per head and sold for an average price of 89 cents a pound.

The Grand Champion pig,

weighing 230 lbs. was shown by Jason Diem, Willow Hill and was purchased by the Greencastle Livestock Market for \$3.20 a pound. The Reserve Champion shown by brother Eric Diem, weighing 250 lbs. was purchased by Hatfield Quality Meats, Hatfield, PA for \$2.00 a pound.


In the Pen-of-two class, Champion honors went to Adam Haldaman, Greencastle, with a pair averaging 247 lbs. that were purchased by Craigs Hog Buying

Station, Greencastle, for \$1.05 a pound. Reserve Champion honors went to Justin Conner, Chambersburg, and averaged 198 lbs. and were purchased by Barvinchack Chiropractic, Greencastle, for .90 cents per pound.

In the Junior Fitting and Showing class, Anna Ruth Kent, St. Thomas was declared Grand Champion while brother Timothy Kent walked away with Reserve Champion honors for the second year in a row. In the Senior division, John Greenawalt, Amberson was Grand Champion while Justin Conner, Chambersburg was declared Reserve Champion.

The show was judged by Henry Gruber, a Penn State alumnus, and pork producer from New Tripoli, PA. Roundup trophies were sponsored by York Farm Credit ACA, of Chambersburg while ribbons and rosettes were provided by the Franklin County 4-H Development Fund.




