**BROCCOLI PASTA**

- 1 pound pasta (spaghetti or fettuccine)
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, pressed
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 head broccolli, chopped
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- freshly grated Parmesan cheese



Cook pasta in boiling water until al dente and drain. While pasta is cooking, sauté the onion and garlic in the olive oil. Add the chopped broccolli and lemon juice, and continue cooking, stirring occasionally, until tender, but not soft. Serve over the drained pasta and garnish with Parmesan cheese, as desired.

Makes 4 servings.

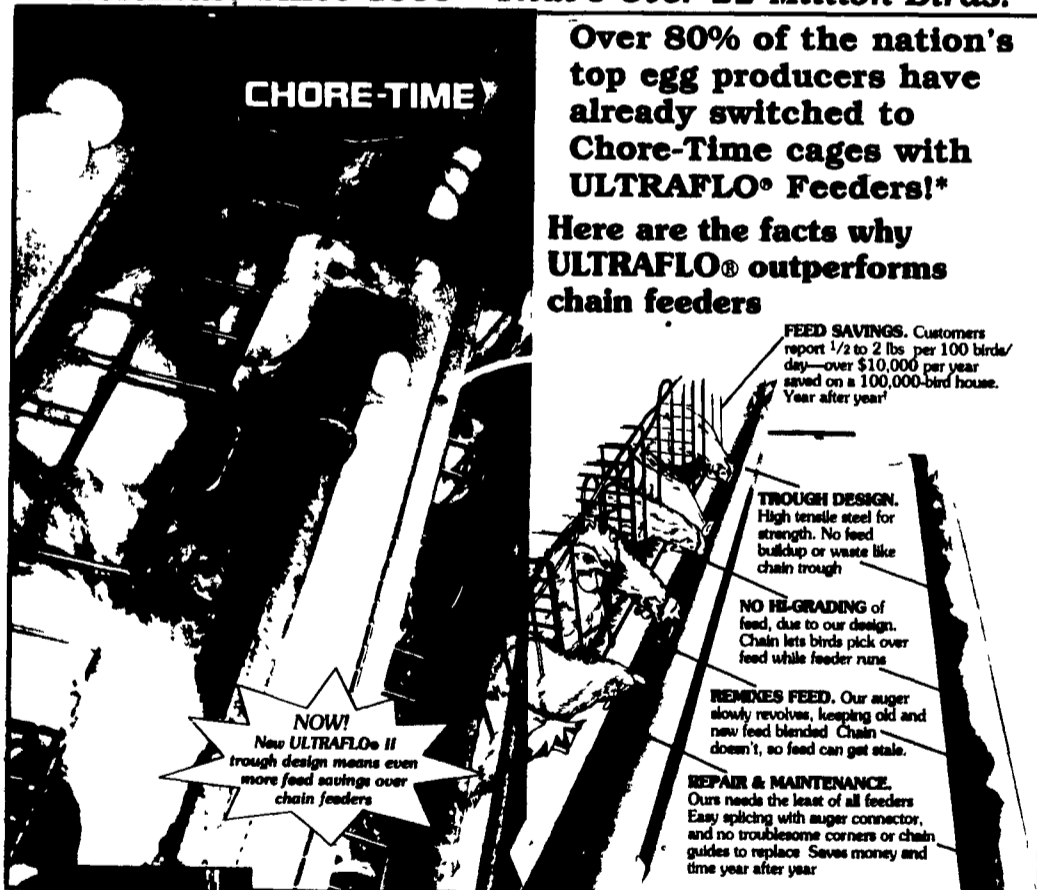

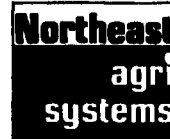

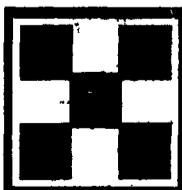
