\$4,181.35. Joe Young's reserve grand champion was bought by Hoss's Steak and Sea House for \$3,199.50. The 1,185-pound steer sold for \$2.70 per pound. Overall, 41 steers sold for \$43,361.62. Hoss's Steak and Sea House also purchased the grand champion swine from Jada Kauffman of Lewistown. The 252-pound animal sold for \$3.30 per pound. Jada's reserve grand champion swine was sold to Steele's Rental Sales and Service for \$2.60 a pound. A total of 99 swine sold for \$23,708.45. Christin Sheaffer's grand champion market lamb brought \$4.90 per pound. Jim Treaster of Eastern Industries placed the high-

est bid. Jamey White of Haubaker Construction in State College bought John Kirk's reserve grand champion market lamb. Overall, 52 market lambs sold for \$6,276.60. Bobbie Dan's FFA grand champion goat went to Olde Mill Pet and Garden for \$2.25 a pound. Paul Brown Excavating bought the reserve grand champion goat from Chrisy Seitz for \$2 a pound. A total of six market goats sold for \$614.25. Gina Epperson's grand champion rabbit sold for \$90 a pound. Norma Fogleman, representing Joe Krentzman & Sons bought that bunny. D. J. Seitz placed the highest bid for Beth Cooper's reserve grand champion. It sold for \$45 per pound. Six rabbits sold for a total of \$774.38.
