Compared to last week: Feeder cattle and calves steady in light holiday trade. Demand moderate for calves, good for yearling cattle. Bulk of supply weighed less than 700 lbs.. Slaughter cows steady to .50 higher. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand good even though many cows in poor buying conditions. Total of 281 cows and bulls sold. 90 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 2,600; last week 12,645; last year 1,269. Supply consisted of 46 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 43 percent calves under 600 lbs; 11 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
