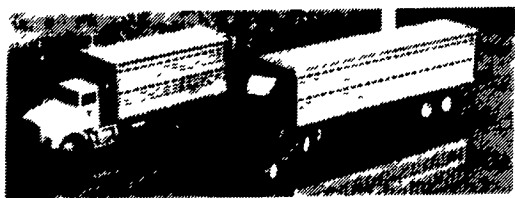

Built by the Winross Company of Rochester New York, trucks are extremely detailed including hundreds of slots punched into the aluminum sides. Semi trucks are 12 inches long, 10 wheelers are about 7 inches and all feature the official Eby logo. Lancaster Stockyards was founded in 1895 and by 1925, while operating as Lancaster Union Stockyards, had grown to become the largest cattle yard east of Chicago
