# Best Friends Take Champion Sheep Honors At Solanco Fair

LOU ANN GOOD Lancaster Farming Staff OUARRYVILLE (Lancaster (0.) — With 55 entries shown by 33 exhibitors, the Solanco Fair Sheep Show on Wednesday started right on par with other years.

Two best friends shared the limelight for the champion market lamb. Ten-year-old Allison Hugha took the grand champion trophy for a crossbred purchased from Lloyd Reiff of Strasburg. Her dassmate Tiffany Dean took the nserve champion trophy with a crossbred purchased from Tim Fleener of Robesonia.

Judge John Eaton said that the two lambs had style, balance, and

muscle. He said that Allison's lamb perhaps had a slight edge in being well-balanced although Tiffany's was a bit longer.

Allison, daughter of Chet and Marie Hughes of Lampeter, has shown her 4-H project sheep for three years. She called the champion Spot because of a dark spot on his back. "I walked him a lot because he was a jumper. He behaved better if he could walk beside his sister," Allison said.

Tiffany had shown the champion market lamb last year at Solanco and this year at the county 4-H Roundup. The 10-year-old daughter of Joan and Gary Dean of Strasburg, called her ewe Dominoes because of his black and white coloring.

The Solanco Fair has only market lamb and showmanship competition, but no breeding sheep.

The showmanship competition was divided into four classes, from which the top two places from each class competed for the grand champion title. Tyler Swansen, a 10th grade Penn Manor FFA'er, impressed the judge with his complete, smooth movements with his lamb and the eye contact he maintained with the judge.

"You can tell he spends time with his lamb," Judge Eaton said.

Tyler's lamb Kendra is one of three that Tyler raises for FFA projects. Tyler is the son of John and Debra Swanson of Conestoga.

Taking the reserve champion showman title was Jessica Schmidt, a previous first-place champion at the fair. She showed her lamb Maverick, which she raises at her parents', Peter and Laurie Schmidt's' farm in Drumore.
