ZUCCHINI BREAD

2 tablespoons dry yeast 1/2 cup warm water 2-1/2 cups white flour 1 cup graham flour 1 cup grated zucchini 3/4 cup plain yogurt 3/4 cup cottage cheese 3 tablespoons minced chives 1 teaspoon salt

nroof yeast in warm water for 10 minutes or until bubbly. Stir in flours and zucchini. Add remaining ingredients and mix well Knead dough on a floured surface about 10 minutes, adding more

Let rise in loaf pans until doubled, about 45 minutes. Brush tops with water and bake in preheated 375° F oven. After 3 minutes, brush tops again with water. Bake 45 to 50

minutes Cool for 10 minutes, then turn out of pans Makes 2 loaves.


