

Bucks County Stages 4-H Lamb Roundup

DOYLESTOWN (Bucks Co.) — Tracy Kimbel of Jamison showed the grand champion lamb at the Bucks County 4-H Market Lamb Roundup held recently at

the Middletown Grange Fair. Her 128-pound purebred Suffolk lamb was purchased at the auction by Worthington Racing Stables of Langhorne for \$450.

Tim Miller of Pennsburg had the reserve champion. First National Bank of Newtown paid \$385 for Tim's 140-pound Suffolk lamb.

In all, 25 4-H members showed and sold their project lambs. The sale averaged \$225/head with the champions and \$208/head when the champions weren't included. The judge was Greg Snyder of Lancaster.

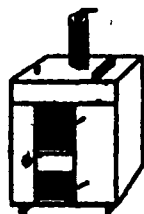
The board reviews and comments on all Commission regulations as they are developed to implement the provisions of the Nutrient Management Act.
