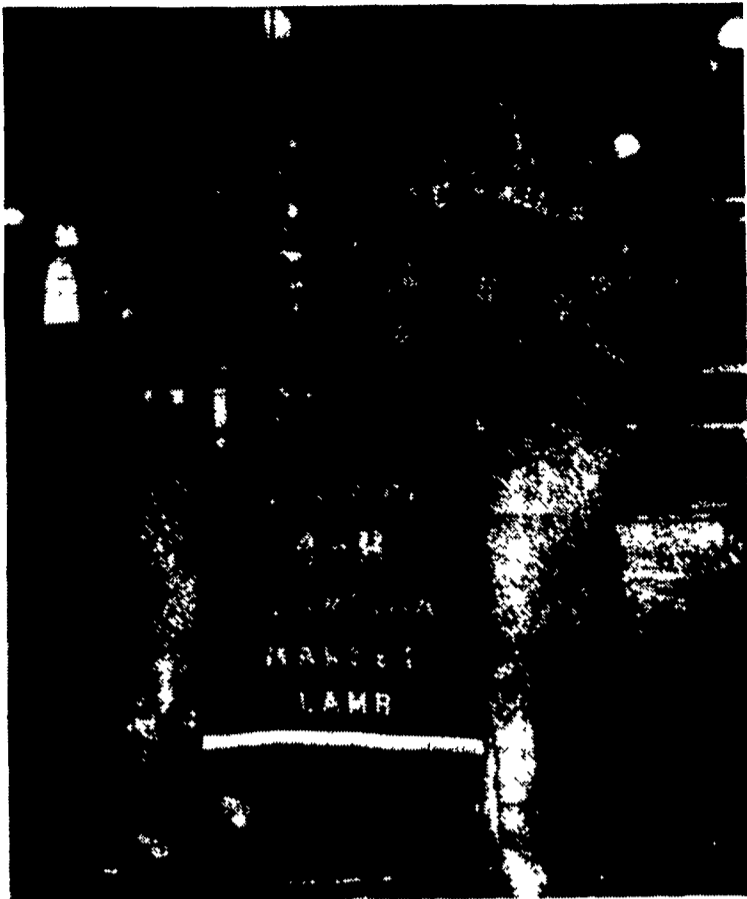


Nicole's Dorset Wins Champion Market Lamb

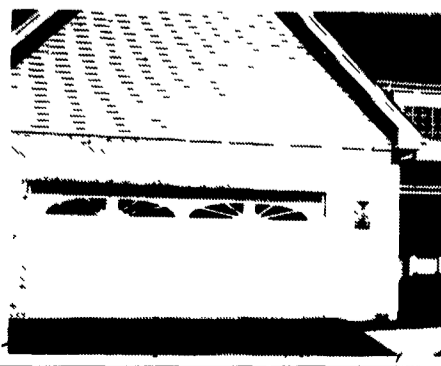
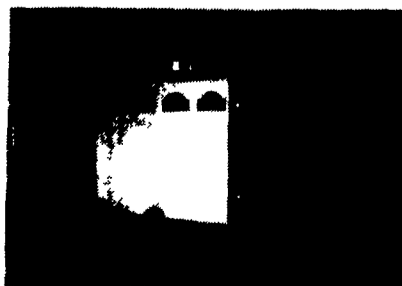
