The livestock was held after the

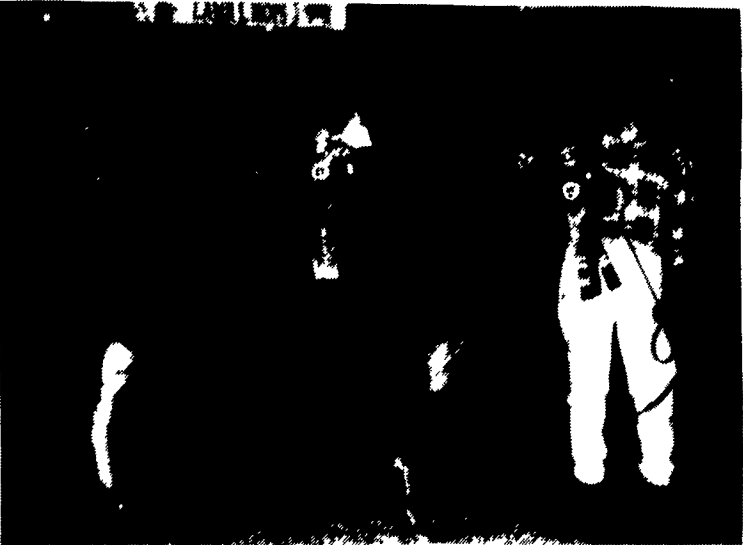
show in the park. Auctioneer was Mark Glick.

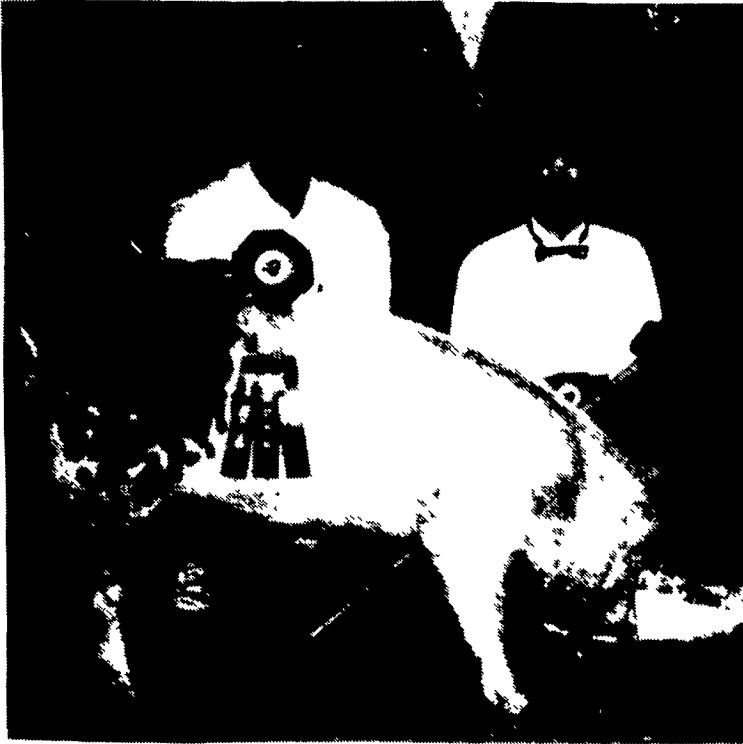

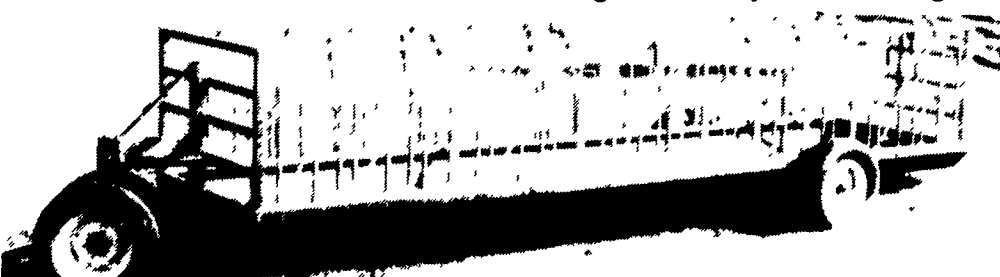

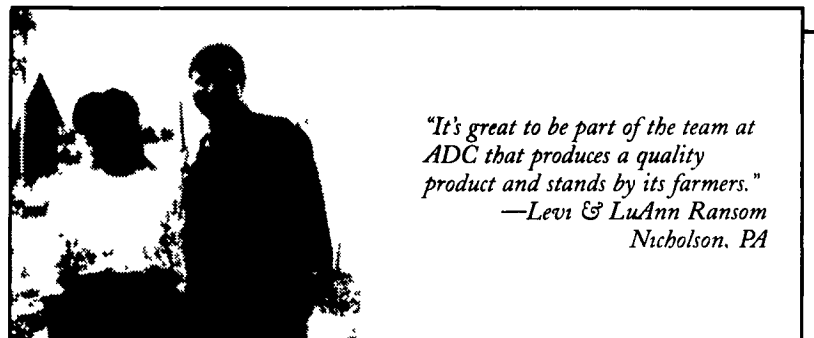
