Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers steady; good demand for steers, moderate for heifers. In stark contrast to last week very few Brahma cross in the feeder cattle supply. Calves steady to 1.00 lower; good demand but an abundance of calves. Feeder flesh medium to slightly thin and typical. Calf flesh medium to very fleshy with many in maximum flesh. Fleshy calf demand good and the best in two years. Calf price structure about the same as last year at this time; yearling structure 3.00-4.00 lower than last year. Quality of supply much improved with better genetics but calf flesh a detriment. Weigh condition full to mostly average. Weather has been perfect for completion of wheat drilling state-wide. Many fields in central Oklahoma are up with several in full ground cover. Many calves will be turned out within the next four weeks but may be more calves available than early

wheat. Western Oklahoma just completing planting and will be needing prolonged Indian summer and moisture to get late November grazing. Slaughter cows firm to 1.50 higher. 
