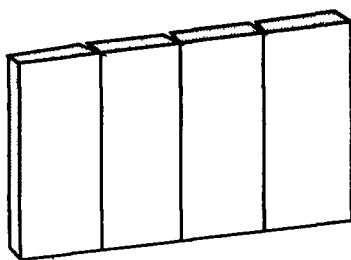

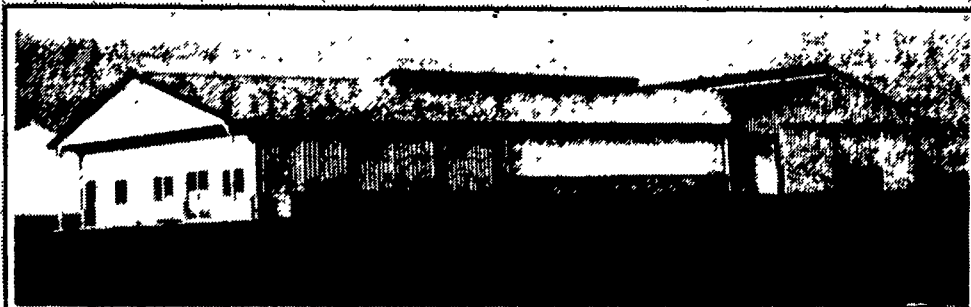

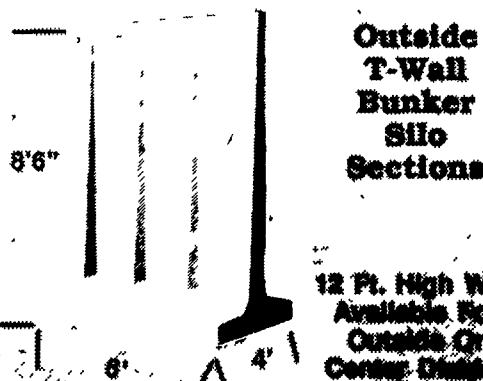

Long Core Cattle Waffle Slats

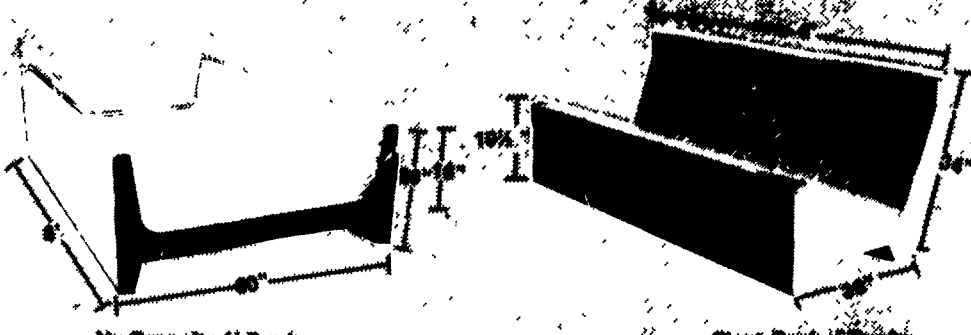


Outside T-Wall Bunker Silo Sections
