OKLAHOMA CITY, OK
DECEMBER 4, 1996

Compared to last week: Steer calves 2.00-4.00 higher; heifer calves steady to 3.00 higher. Feeder steers and heifers steady to 1.00 higher. Demand very good for all classes. Quality of supply average. Bulk supply calves with true yearlings rather scarce. Receipts curtailed by wet weekend weather and muddy conditions statewide. Feeder heifer buyers have become very cautious on heifers that do not have a youthful appearance. Slaughter cows 1.00-3.00 lower. Demand rather light with several major players out of the market at this level. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand fair. 750 cows and bulls sold with 75 percent to packers. Receipts this week 5,550; last week 4,850; last year 14,188.

Supply consisted of 29 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 57 percent calves under 600 lbs; 14 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 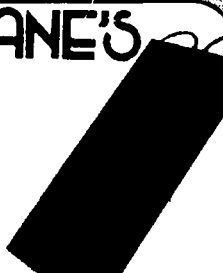

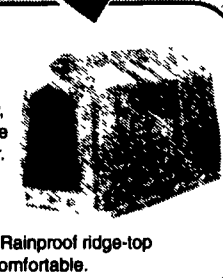
