Compared to last Monday: Feeder steers and heifers steady to 1.00 higher with good demand. Steer calves steady to 2.00 higher;

heifer calves 2.00-4.00 higher. Demand good for heifer calves and 4 wt steers, moderate for other steer calves. Quality of supply plain to average, with modest end attractive calves. Fleish condition of calves highly varied with many medium to thin, but several fleshy. Weigh conditions of calves and yearlings mostly average. Supply included modest number of yearlings off wheat. Weather clear and mild and perfect for moving calves. Buyers relieved with correction in stock market as this may have been largest concern to cattle demand this week. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Demand moderate. Some increase in combelt participation but southern buyers continue to take bulk of slaughter cows and bulls. Replacement buyers very active and aggressive for numbers. Near 1100 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent to packers. Receipts this week 17,550; last week 5,583; last year 11,244. Supply consisted of 53 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 41 percent calves under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and prices in parenthesis. 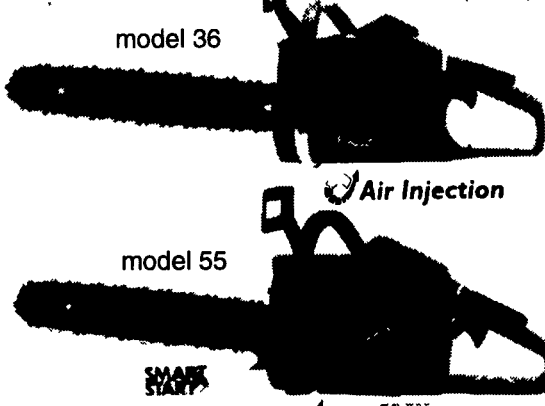
