OKLAHOMA CITY, OK  
DECEMBER 18, 1996

Compared to last Monday: Feeder steers and heifers steady. Steer calves steady to 2.00 higher; heifer calves 2.00-3.00 lower. Demand moderate. Buyers much less aggressive than last week as major cold front enters the region. This expected to cause hazardous hauling conditions to feedlots and it's no time to be caring for new calf arrivals. Numerous steers off wheat pasture in supply and these in mostly medium condition. Calves in medium to fairly thin condition. Quality of supply average. Weigh-ups mostly average. Slaughter cows steady. Slaughter bulls 2.00 lower. Demand moderate for cows and bulls. 650 cows and bulls sold with 65 percent to packers. Receipts this week 11,350; last week 17,615; last year 7,065. Supply consisted of 53 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 41 percent calves under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
