### **FULL LONG NIGHTS MOON**

hristmas Eve marks the night of the Full Long Nights Moon this year, so carolers should have a U well-lit path, despite the longer periods of darkness this time of year. The good news is that the length of daylight has already increased by a full minute from its all-year low of 9 hours, 4 minutes. (In June the daylight stretches to about 15 hours, 17 minutes, by comparison.) According to the old moonlore, if Christmas comes during a waning Moon (as this year), it predicts a hard year to come. However, the nearer to the end of the waning Moon, the worse the luck, and this year's Christmas Moon is barely a day into its wane, so it can't be all that bad . .






