In agricultural salesmanship, each student had to prepare products to sell, take a written test, prepare a sales pitch, and complete a practicum (design a poster to help sell citrus fruit). Louis Jones placed 4th, Cheri Chalfant place 9th, and Nicole Moyer and Joel Graydus were also team members.

In the dairy foods contest, students took a written test, sampled milk to identify defects, tasted cheeses, tested defective milk for mastitis (a disease of the udder), and identified real and artificial dairy products. In the wildlife contest, students had to identify birds, mammals, wildlife foods and signs, bird calls, and take a written test.


