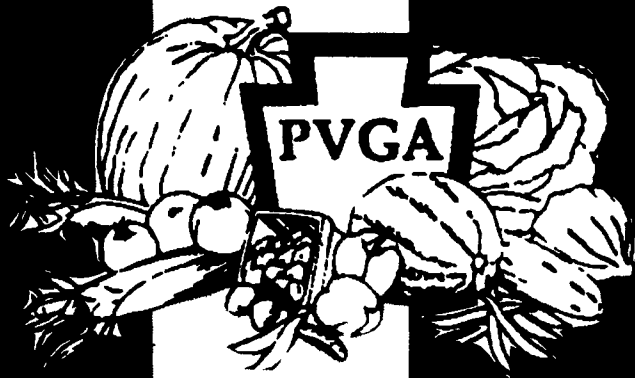
Matthew plans to study ag engineering at a four-year college.

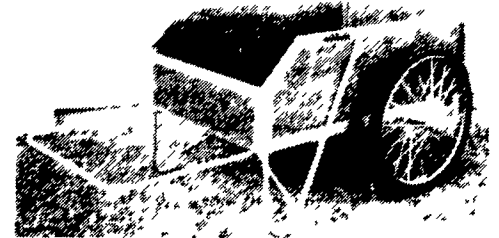
