DELMARVA BROILER/FRYER MARKET. FEDERAL-STATE

Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was light and selective, and generally centered on limited supplies of 2.5 pound sizes. 3 pound and heavier sizes were readily available and slow to clear. Live supplies were mostly moderate; weights varied, but were often noted as heavier than desired. Processing schedules were moderately heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 66 to 80 cents. Trade sentiment was steady to weak. In the parts complex, boneless skinless breasts were adequate to fully adequate. Bone-in breasts were in good balance. Most leg items were available and slow in clearing. Wings were in tight supply.
