Cold weather conditions return for most of the US, offering support to grain and soybean bids. Gains were limited, however, by continued lack of foreign sales this week. Wheat 2 to 8 cents higher. Corn 1 to 2 cents higher. Sorghum 2 to 4 cents higher. Soybeans 3 to 6 cents higher. Winterkill threats in winter wheat areas continue to push wheat bids higher as temperatures are forecast to drop drastically. Corn and soybean bids were stronger due to higher wheat bids. Traders await Friday's USDA reports. Reports of hot, dry weather in parts of Brazil added support to bean bids.

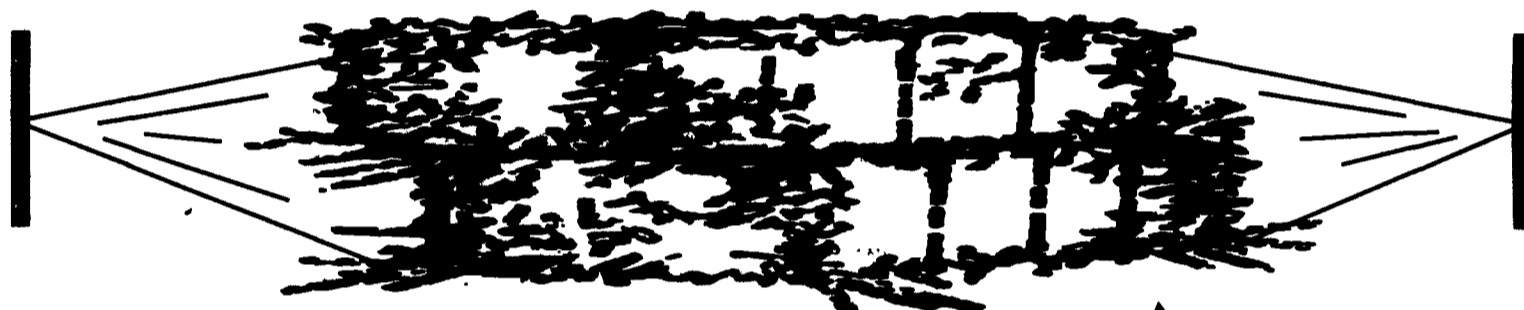
