Alisha plans to attend Penn State or Delaware Valley College to major in dairy and animal science.

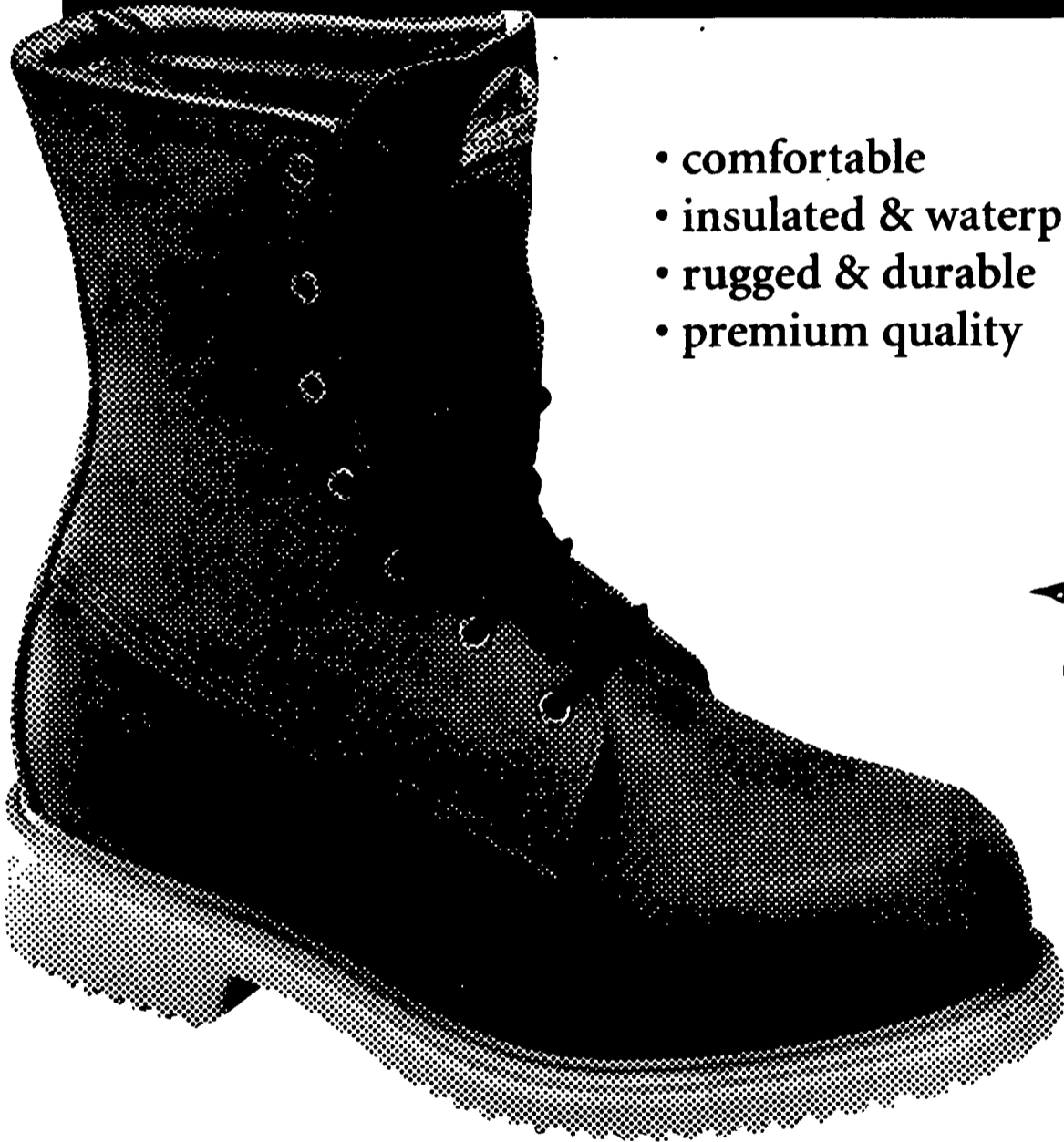

She has received the Greenhand and chapter degrees.

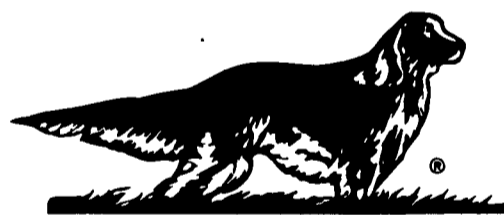
