**MOZART'S BIRTHDAY**

Composer Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born on January 27, 1756, and was quickly recognized as a child prodigy. Some thank his father for promoting his genius; others blame him for the "workaholic" who died at 35, only to be buried in an unidentified pauper's grave. Mozart's famous librettist, Lorenzo Da Ponte (*The Marriage of Figaro* and *Don Giovanni*) led an even more colorful life than Mozart but, like the composer, was frequently in debt. In 1805, Da Ponte left Europe for New York to seek his fortune. Mozart had died earlier, in 1791, of typhus, worsened by exhaustion and overwork. He had composed over 600 works.

- 1 6-ounce can frozen lemonade concentrate, reconstituted

- 1/8 teaspoon cloves
- 4 cardamom pods
- 1/4 cup raisins (optional)
- 3 tablespoons sugar
- 1 orange, sliced
- 1 lemon, sliced



Combine all ingredients except for the fruit slices, and heat to steaming. When ready to serve, float citrus slices on top.

Makes 10 to 12 servings.

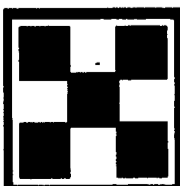
