OKLAHOMA CITY, OK  
JANUARY 22, 1997

Compared to the last two weeks: Feeder steers and heifers 2.00-3.00 higher. Steer and heifer calves 4.00-6.00 higher. Demand very good for all classes. Supply mostly feeder cattle and weaned calves. Quality of supply average to attractive. Weigh-ups gaunt to average, few full. Flesh condition of feeders over 700 lbs medium to slightly fleshy, few fleshy. Lighter weight cattle medium to thin. Slaughter cows 1.00 lower than last weeks weather market. Slaughter bulls 1.50 lower. Slaughter market still 2.00 higher than December and early January. Demand moderate. 650 cows and bulls sold with 70 percent to packers. Receipts this week 15,575; last week 1170; last year 7,822. Supply consisted of 69 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 27 percent calves under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 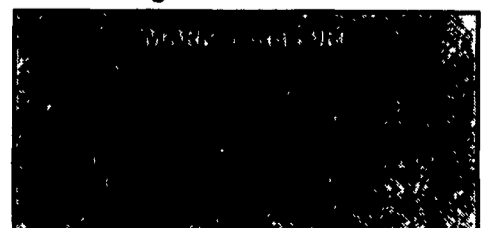
