

# Watershed Planning Conference Set

OXFORD (Chester Co.) — An all-day conference with the theme of integrating natural resource management with land planning is set to be held April 4 at the Stroud Water Research Center in Avondale.

The conference is to consist of two half-day sessions. One is to be devoted to natural resource management and the other to land planning and development.

The conference is being organized by environmental consulting firm Landstudies Inc. in cooperation with the Stroud Water Research Center. The Stroud Center is a national recognized fresh water laboratory, a field station of the Academy of Natural Science in Philadelphia.

The conference is being co-sponsored by the Society of American Foresters; the Valley Forge Chapter and the Octoraro

Wetland/Native nurseries; Pennsylvania Trout; and the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay.

"This conference will demonstrate watershed planning techniques that focus on implementation," said Mark Gutshall, president of Landstudies Inc. "Speakers will present case studies and provide references for use in local watersheds."

Bernard W. Sweeney, director of the Stroud Center, is to deliver the keynote talk on watershed planning in Pennsylvania.

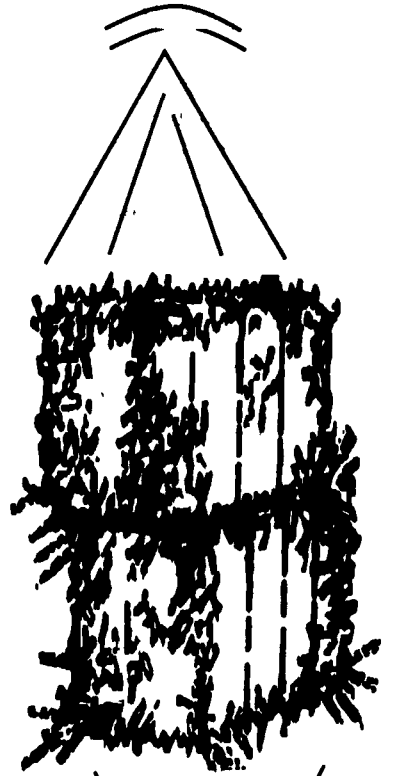
Some of the topics to be covered under natural resource management, and the speakers of those topics, as confirmed of this week, include: Frank Lucas with the U.S. Natural Resources Conservation Service who is to talk about agricultural best management practices on Pequea/Mill Creek; Dan Zimmerman, Warwick Township Manager, who is to discuss the

restoration of the Lititz Run Watershed; Roxanne Palone, a watershed specialist who is to discuss a riparian forest buffer handbook for the Chesapeake Bay Watershed; and Sweeney, who is to also discuss forested riparian buffers.

Under land planning and development issues, speakers include Calista Santhe with RoLanka, on the role of coir product in soil bio-engineering; Earl Shaver, with the state Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Conservation on the stormwater management handbook; Carl DuPoldt, with the NRCS, who is to talk about the Pennsylvania Best Management Practices Handbook; and Andy Johnson, a conservation advisor, who is to discuss limited development.

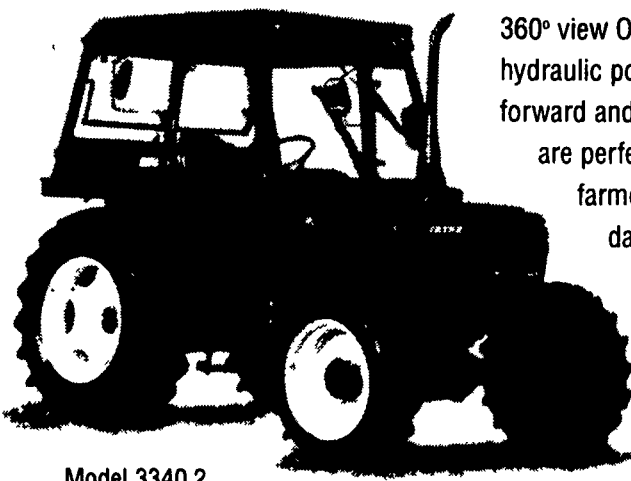

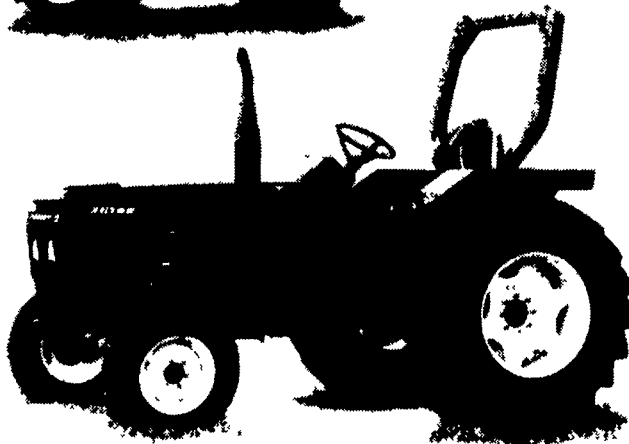

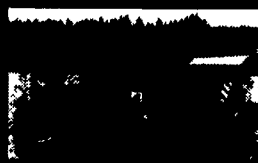
