FEBRUARY 14, 1997
 Prices were unchanged to higher for whites, and generally lower for whole and yolk. The market tone was at least steady for whites, and barely steady to weak on the balance. Demand was light for trucklot volumes, and less-than-trucklot orders were mixed with some improvement noted in metropolitan areas with Passover business. Floor stocks were adequate to fully adequate. Liquid and frozen eggs (ingredients included) processed under federal inspection in the East for the week ending February 8, 1997 were 1% more than last week, and 23% more than the same week last year.

 Trucklot buying activity was slow and disappointing. Demand was light with increase availability noted on most items. However, wings were ample with little or no interest noted at the higher levels. Distributive and retail movement was light to moderate, best where specials were in progress. Undertone was usually weak on wings, barely steady on legs and leg quarters. Although, offerings of white leg quarters were limited. Balance of items were usually reported as cautious but generally steady.

National Egg Market

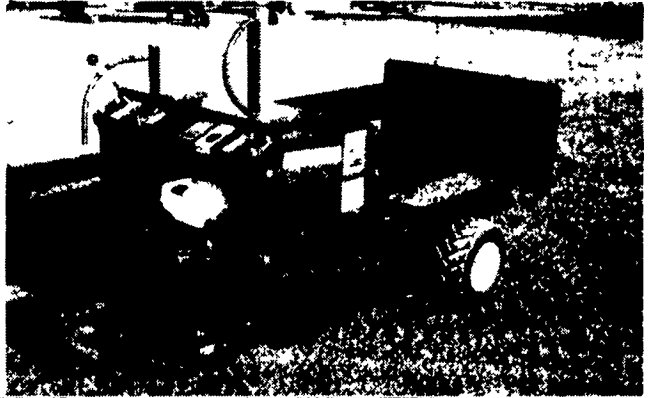
FEBRUARY 19, 1997

Retail demand had improved and ranged light to instances good, best where features were in progress or planned for upcoming weekend. Loose egg demand was moderate. Suppliers were adequate to fully adequate. The national egg inventory increased by 1 percent over the previous week. Breaking stock supplies were also adequate to fully adequate. Live hen offerings were short to about adequate for processing requirements.

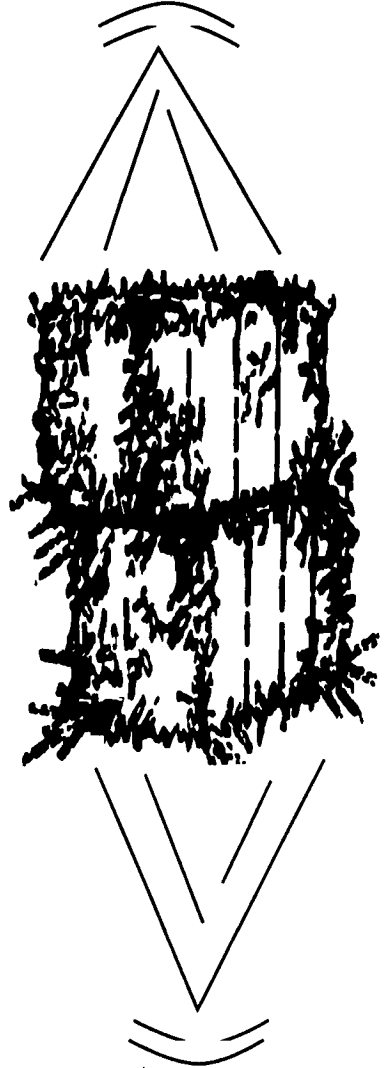
