

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) — The fourth annual Penn State Master Gardener Symposium is scheduled for Saturday, March 15, at the Cooperative Extension Office located on Arcadia Road in Lancaster. Designed to service both novice and professional gardeners, recognized horticulture experts are featured: David E. Benner, botanical consultant for Bowman's Hill State Wildflower Preserve at Washington Crossing State Park in Pennsylvania; David Culp, a sales representative for

Sunny Borders Nurseries, Inc. in Connecticut whose garden is featured regularly on the Home and Garden Channel, in Rodale's publications and in *Gardening with Perennials*; Judith C. McKeon, chief horticulturist at the Morris Arboretum of the University of Pennsylvania, and rosarian in charge of the award-winning Arboretum rose garden in 1984; Betty Mackey, author of *The Gardener's Home Companion*, co-author and regular columnist who has been published in *Flower and*

*Gardens, The Green Scene, Burpee Home Gardener* among many others; and Fred Spicer, superintendent of horticulture for the Morris County Park Commission, New Jersey.
