COLLEGEVILLE (Montgomery Co.) — Are you interested in fashions, good grooming, physical fitness, hair styling, wardrobe planning, poise and posture? Both programs will run for six consecutive Tuesdays, beginning April 1 and ending May 6. In Upper Dublin the course will run from 4-5:30

The course will be taught by Ashley Custer, 4-H Program Instructor. 4-H charges \$10 for the course; other locations may tack on a small addition for site rental. Scholarships are available with no questions asked.

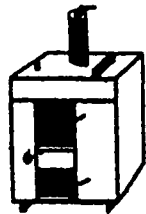

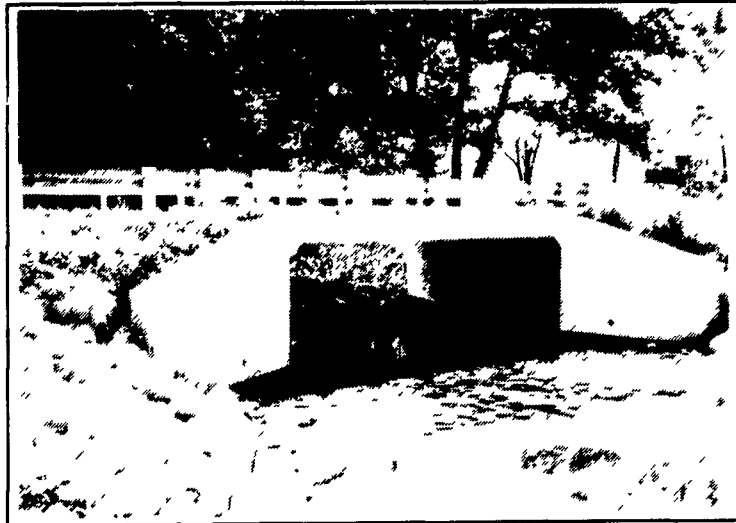

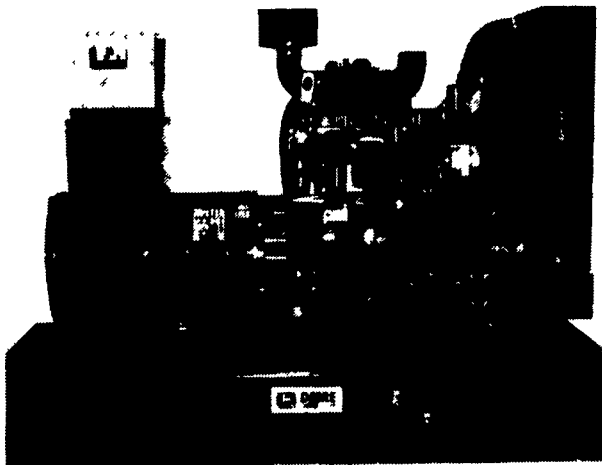
