MAYFLOWER LAUNCHING

Forty years ago, on March 16, 1957, the Mayflower's shallop was launched in Plymouth, Massachusetts It was a reproduction of the Pilgrim ship, of course, not the original, but we salute it nonetheless. A shallop (from the French chaloupe or Dutch sloep, for sloop) is an open boat fitted with oars or sails or both Despite the animosity that

BROILED EGGPLANT

1 medium eggplant 2 tablespoons olive oil 4 tablespoons basil pesto salt and pepper juice of 1 lemon grated Parmesan


