Buyers best bargain for short term gain on graze out wheat is the heavy weight stockers and this is what fuels demand for these cattle this time of year. Quality of supply average. Feeder cattle continue in medium to fleshy condition. Weigh-ups gaunt to full, mainly gaunt to average. Additional corn belt buyers arrived this week but not particularly active. 
