

Greiner spoke at the banquet, trying to dispel the myth that the school is an "all-boys" school, pointing out that of 35 students the past year, 10 were girls. "We all need to be exposed to conservation education," he said.


B. Frank Lucas, leader of the Pequea-Mill Creek Project, was honored for his work. Lucas spoke briefly about the water quality efforts of the project, encompassing some 135,000 acres and more than 1,000 farms in the Pequea-Mill Creek watershed. He said the watershed has about 55,000 cows — "The heaviest concentration of dairy cows anywhere in the U.S.," he said. "They're really packed in."

Lucas spoke about the benefits of streambank fencing to promote herd health, water quality, and wildlife and fish habitat.

In addition, Nancy Burkhart was honored with a special award for her contributions to the district. The Keystone Chapter of the Soil and Water Conservation Society presented a special award to Steve Groff of Cedar Meadow Farms for the promotion of no-till agriculture in vegetable and other crops on his farm.

Two individuals from the Litz Run watershed were honored for conservation work — Harold Alleman of the Litz Sportsmen's Association and Greg Wilson, president of the local chapter of Trout Unlimited.

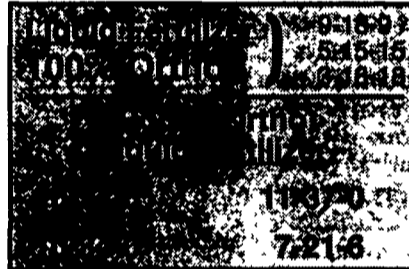
